

Having made his first steps on a VLCC, Stefanos concluded his service as deck-officer on chemical tankers and continued his academic education in Maritime Studies and Economics.

Various positions in marine operations departments gave him the initial experience on-board before joining the oil spill response industry. Training through real life marine incidents, along with an MSc degree in "Quality Management in Shipping", and academic research (PhD) position in the field of Environmental Economics have provided the experience and know how on managing complex casualties and projects.

Since 2014 he has focused on the provision of easy-to-access training working along with oil majors, National Administrations, European Maritime Safety Agency and lately with IMO for a publication on the development of joint oil spill response exercises.

John is a very experienced marine and emergency management professional. He has over 25 years' experience in the marine industry in both seagoing and fleet management roles with leading industry organizations.
